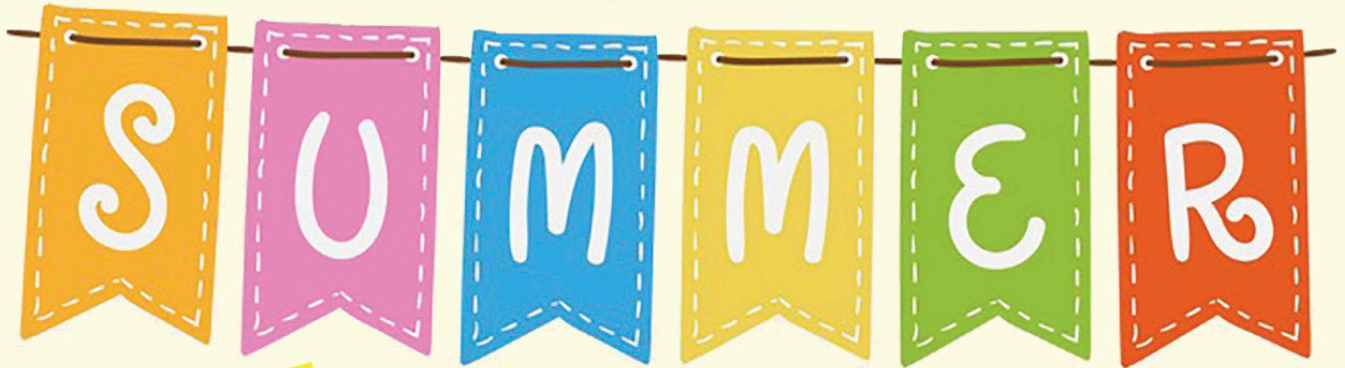

SENSEI RICHIE SELECTED AS USA REPRESENTATIVE AT IJF REFEREE SEMINAR IN DOHA, QATAR

January 8, 2020

Doha, Qatar

From Marius L. Vizer, President of the International Judo Federation: "The year 2020 is one of great importance for the sport of judo. With the Olympic Games to be held in Tokyo, Japan - the birthplace of our sport, all eyes of the world will be on our athletes and our competition.

We are already witnessing a great interest in the Olympic judo competition and Tokyo 2020 will be a perfect occasion for all of us to harvest the fruits of the work and activity we had in the past four years. We are hoping to be able to present outstanding judo performances and impeccable organization, as well as a display of the judo values and principles which guide and unite us.

The IJF Refereeing and Coaching Seminar 2020 takes place in Doha, Qatar, a location which we will return to in the following period for several competitions and where we hope to develop our sport and increase its presence in the Qatari society. COMMUNITY KITCHEN

SOBORO-DONBURI

Misty Tamanaha

Ingredients

1 lb Ground Chicken	2 Tbsp Sugar (adjust to taste)
2 Tbsp Avocado Oil	2 Tbsp Mirin
2 tsp Fresh Grated Ginger	3 Tbsp Shoyu (adjust to taste)
2 Tbsp Sake	
2 Large Eggs	1 Tbsp Avocado Oil
1 Tbsp Sugar	
Steamed Rice	Steamed Green Beans

Recipe Instructions

In a frying pan add avocado oil and cook ground chicken thoroughly, breaking the meat down into small pieces. Add sake, sugar, mirin. Then add shoyu. Continuing to break meat into small pieces. Add grated ginger and it's juice. Cook down until the liquid is almost gone. Beat eggs and sugar together in a small bowl. In a frying, add avocado oil, begin cooking and stirring eggs with 4-6 chop sticks to break the cooking eggs into small pieces. Cut steamed green beans into small pieces. Assemble cooked ground chicken, eggs and steamed green beans over a bed of steamed rice. ENJOY!

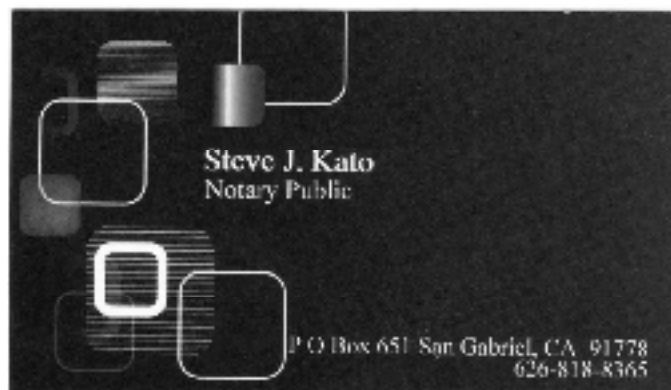
